G. Executive Short-Term Diploma and Certificate Programmes

- The short-term Executive certificate and diploma courses are run on demand, in line with the needs or focus of the sponsoring organisation or group, in which case the programme durations are not fixed. Courses include: Business Administration; Public Administration; Fundamentals of Marketing; Accounting for Non- Accountants; Office and information Management; E-Business and Commerce; Industrial and Human Resource Management; Taxation for Non-Taxation Experts; Finance for Non-Finance Managers; Hospitality and Tourism Management; Logistics and Supply Chain management; Public Diplomacy and International Relations; Maritime Management; Project Management; Real Estate Finance; Small Scale Business Finance; Agricultural and allied Marketing; Treasury Management; Agric Business; Financial Management; International Business; Real Estate Business; Accounting for Small Scale Business; Micro-Credit Business; Farm Management; Health and Safety Management
- These short-term programmes are intended to run for 1-6 months for interested organisations, firms or groups whose staff or members meet any of the requirements below, as well as individuals who meet the requirements, can participate in the certificate programmes and short courses of DELSU Business School. Candidates that have obtained an OND/NCE/Diploma and have a minimum of three (3) years work or self-employment experience could be considered. Candidates with lower qualifications than above, but who have considerable work experience, or are self-employed could also be considered.

H. DURATION OF THE PROGRAMMES

(1) Postgraduate Diploma (PGD) Programme

Two (2) Semesters Minimum; Four (4) Semesters Maximum

(2) Executive MBA/MPA/Masters programme

Eighteen (18) Months: Three (3) Semesters Minimum; Six (6) Semesters Maximum

(3) Executive DBA/Doctoral Programme

36 Months: Six (6) Semesters: 3 Years. DBA candidates are expected to be in revision class for at least one week before the semester examination.

(4) M.Sc. programme

Minimum 24 months (2 years) of four semesters, maximum 48 months (4 years) of eight semesters.

(5) PhD programme

Minimum 36 Months (3 years) of six semesters, maximum 60 months (5 years) of ten semesters.

I. MODE OF STUDY

The DELSU Business School runs a flexible mode of study which includes interactive teaching (online learning inclusive), and action learning. Also there are weekday, weekend or evening lectures, case studies and presentations options. Applicants are allowed to choose their preferred mode of study.

J. LOCATION OF PROGRAMME

The DELSU Business School programmes are located at two centre and candidates are allowed to run their programme at the location of their choice. The two centres are located at Abraka and Asaba

K. TIME TO APPLY FOR ADMISSION

Admission applications into the DELSU Business School programmes are open throughout the year.

L. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

(a) Postgraduate Diploma

(i) First Degree in the relevant discipline from any recognized higher institution/university with a minimum of a third class honours degree.

(ii) Higher National Diploma (HND) in the relevant discipline from any recognized Polytechnic.

(b) MBA/Masters Programme

A minimum of Second-Class Lower Division in the relevant discipline from any recognized higher institution/university or Higher National Diploma (HND) or Postgraduate Diploma (PGD).

(c) Doctor of Business Administration (DBA)/Doctoral Programmes

A minimum of Masters/MBA Degree in relevant discipline from a recognized higher institution/university.

(d) Masters/Master of Science (M.Sc) Programme

Candidate applying for Masters/M.Sc Degree must be holders of bachelor's degree in the relevant discipline from any recognized university with minimum of Second Class Honours (Lower Division) Degree. Holders of MBA who also possess final professional qualifications of recognized relevant professional bodies will be considered.

(e) PhD Programme

A candidate for the Ph.D. Programme must possess an M.Sc. in the relevant discipline from any recognized university with a minimum CGPA of 3.50 or obtained a weighted average score of 60%.

NOTE: All candidates for postgraduate studies must have obtained at least five (5) credit passes, in WASC, NECO, GCE (Ordinary Level), or NABTEB at not more than two (2) sittings, which must include English Language and Mathematics.

M. METHOD OF APPLICATION

Candidates seeking admission into the DELSU Business School can obtain application forms ONLINE on payment of a non-refundable application fee of =N=41,000 payable at any of the following banks: UBA, Zenith Bank, Unity Bank, Fidelity Bank, after generating an application virtual pin. Thereafter candidates should log-on to www.delsu.edu.ng and follow the procedure stated.
