ADMISSION INTO THE NEW DIPLOMA COURSES FOR 2019/2020 SESSION

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for admission into the following Regular Diploma programmes:

FACULTY OF THE SOCIAL SCIENCES

Duration of study is four Semester Or an Intensive Eight weeks professional contact

1) Accounting.

Candidate should possess Senior Secondary School Certificate (SSCE) or its equivalent (Teacher grade II, WASC, GCE Ordinary Level, NECO, NABTEB, RSA awarded by WAEC) with a minimum of five credit passes in English Language, Mathematics, Economics and two other subjects from the following Business Methods, Principle of Account, Literature in English, Commerce, History Statistics, Geography, Government Agric Science/Biology obtained at not more than two sittings.

2) Business Administration

Candidate must possess a minimum of Five (5) credit passes in the Senior Secondary School Certificate (SSCE) NECO or General Certificate of Education (GCE) including English Language, Mathematics, Economics and two Social science subjects obtained at not more than two sittings.

3) Social Work

A minimum of Five credit passes in the Senior Secondary School Certificate (SSCE) NECO or General Certificate of Education (GCE) O Level TCII or their equivalent including English Language, Mathematics and two social science subjects obtained at not more than two sittings.

4) Criminology and Security Studies.

A minimum of Five credit passes in the Senior Secondary School Certificate (SSCE) NECO or General Certificate of Education (GCE) O Level TCII or their equivalent including English Language Mathematics and two social science subject obtained at not more than two sittings.

5) Public Administration

A minimum of Five (5) O' Level credit passes in the Senior Secondary School Certificate (SSCE) NECO or General Certificate of Education (GCE) O Level NABTEB, TCII or their equivalent including English Language Mathematics, Government and two social science subjects.

6) Mass Communication

A minimum of Five (5) O' Level credit passes in the Senior Secondary School Certificate (SSCE) NECO or General Certificate of Education (GCE) O Level including English Language, Mathematics and Literature in English and two social science subjects.

7) Marketing

A minimum of 5 credit passes in Senior Secondary School Certificate (SSCE), NECO or General Certificate of Education , Ordinary level (GCE O/L) TC II or their equivalent including English Language, Mathematics and Economics and any other two social science subjects obtained at not more than two sittings

8) SECURITY PROGRAMMES OPTIONS

i) Security Intelligence and Strategic Studies

A minimum of five (5) O Level Credits which should include English and a pass in Mathematics

ii) Environmental Crime Detection, Prevention, Monitoring and Control. using Satellite Data and GIS Analysis,

A minimum of Five (5) O' Level credits which should include 'Mathematics, English Physics or Geography.

iii) Financial Security, Data Analysis, And corruption and Allied Studies

A minimum of Five (5) O Level credits which should include Mathematics, English Language or Accounting.

9) PEACE PROGRAMME OPTIONS

i) Peace Building strategic and Development Studies

A minimum of Five (5) O' Level credits which should include English and a pass in Mathematics.

10) CONFLICT RESOLUTION PROGRAMME OPTIONS

i) Conflict Studies/Resolution Strategies and Risk Management

ii) NGOs' Role, Humanitarian and Refugee Studies and Disaster Management

A minimum of Five (5) O' Level credits with, a pass in Mathematics.

11) GENDER PROGRAMME OPTIONS

i) Gender Security, Safety Development and Risk Management.

ii) Gender and Children (Pry and Sec.) Security Studies, Development and Education.

A minimum of Five (5) O' Level credits with a pass in Mathematics.

12) DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME OPTIONS

i) Water Resources Security, Planning, Demand and Supply Management.

ii) Environmental Planning, Plans, Building Strategies, Compaction and Cementation.

1 & 2 a minimum of Five (5) O' Level credits including Mathematics, Geology or Geography with a pass in English.

iii) Media Resources and Communication Studies, practice, Innovation and Security Strategic studies.

A minimum of Five (5) O' Level credits including English, Literature and a pass in Mathematics.

Items 8 to 12 are specially designed for job seekers, including School Certificate holders, Graduates, Staff of Oil and Servicing Companies, Banks, etc. Also for specialized professionals like **Army, Navy, Air Force, DSS, Customs, Immigration NPF, EFCC, NDLEA, FRSC, Civil Defence Corps, Fire Services, Prisons**, Government Establishments and Ministries, Institutions like Primary and Post Primary Schools, Colleges of Education, Polytechnics, Universities, NGOs, etc.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

Candidates are required to visit www.delsuonline.com to generate virtual pin of N15,000.00 (Fifteen Thousand Naira) only and make payment to any of the following banks: Ecobank, Unity Bank, Zenith Bank, and UBA.

2. (a) Candidates should, with the pin for payment access and complete the Delta State University, Abraka, 2019/2020 Diploma Form Online at <http://www.delsuonline.com> with their recent coloured passport sized photograph scanned to the JPEG format and not more than 20kb in size.

(b) Candidates are advised to use virtual pin immediately after payment as the pin will be invalid after six (6) hours of generation.

(c) Candidates are advised to read the instructions on the front page of the website before completing the form.

(d) Online application starts on Tuesday, 27th August, 2019.

(e) Application Website closes by 6.00pm. on Friday December 27th 2019.

- (a) Candidates are to submit the print-out evidence of application along With copies of their Results to the Centre for Continuing Education Programmes' (CCEP) Office, latest Tuesday December 31st 2019.
