On assumption of duty, the first step Professor Egwunyenga took was to direct all academic staff to duly register in Google Scholar with their publications and their profiles fully captured in the University website. This had an immediate positive outcome as the improvement on the visibility of the University propelled its ranking from the 78<sup>th</sup> position to 38<sup>th</sup> position only a few months later and then 31st position in about a year. This quantum leap in ranking is a testament of how the Vice Chancellor understanding, leadership and simple application of the ICT potentials can drive the University image, ranking, modernization and internationalization.

Today and still counting, DELSU has been continually rising in various ranking bodies and our ICT continually fast growing. With due regards to the University Committee headed by the Deputy Vice Chancellor (Administration), Prof Rosemary Okoh, on the Tenure Report which be published in the coming days, permit me to let a bit of the cat out of the bag as I inform all of us that we should look forward to reading about the very remarkable and enriching **PROGRESS/ACHIEVEMENT REPORT OF THE ICT DIRECTORATE FROM APRIL 2020 – DATE.**
