ABOUT DELTA STATE UNIVERSITY

Delta State University, Abraka, established in 1992 by the Delta State Government, has evolved into a multi campus university system with a campus at Oleh another at the Anwai and a Teaching Hospital at Oghara. At Abraka, the Main campus is spread out on three sites. Site I is the location of the former College of Education which at the time was the apex and core teacher training institution

of the former Midwest Region, one of the four regions into which Nigeria was divided up until 1966. Site II located on the south bank of the majestic and picturesque to accommodate the new University into which the College of Education had metamorphosed. Rapid development and expansion in the new millennium has resulted in the sprawling Site III that now houses major structures and facilities.
